With more than 2000 described species in over 100 genera, Gnaphosidae is the seventh most diverse spider family, out of 108. Gnaphosids are distributed over all parts of the globe. This new Atlas provides an identification aid to gnaphosid genera, it represents the present state of knowledge of the family, and is an excellent review of Gnaphosidae throughout the world.
